Dear Parents and Students,

Student Appreciation Day is on Friday, October 30, 2009. We hope that the following directions bring some clarity.

- Students in ALL grades should use items of clothing that they already own.
- At no point should a student purchase a Halloween costume to be worn in school.
- Students ARE NOT permitted to wear face or hair paint.
- Nail polish MAY be worn for this day ONLY.
- ALL clothing selected for this day MUST be appropriate to wear in school.

Grade K-3 Students- Students will dress down and use the Mixed-Up or Sports theme. It is as easy as two different colored socks or shoes. The shirt could clash with the pants. If students want to wear a crazy hat this is acceptable too. Also, students could wear a sports jersey with jeans.

Grade 4-8 Students – Students in these grades will have a choice. They can dress Mixed-Up, Sports, or Twin theme. There is NO pressure here. You could dress alike by using sports attire or wear same colors. There are many options to this theme. Please make sure whatever your choice that it is APPROPRIATE to wear in school.
